Terms to know

Color —a specific combination of hue saturation and lightness or brightness

Primary Colors —Red, yellow, blue. Can be used to make many color.

Secondary Colors —Green, orange, violet. Adjacent to primary colors.

Tertiary Colors —a hue that is mixed from a primary color and an adjacent secondary color.

Hue —the name of a color. Example: Red or Yellow

Procedure

Make your color swatches at least 3 inches square. Once dry, use a 1 inch hole punch/ square punch (get it from me) to cut your final shapes. Organize your circles of colors into a circle that measures 7.5 inches in diameter and compose on a 10" x 10" piece of Stonehenge (see diagram at bottom of page).
