

## Neutralize Colors Project

### Design 1

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#### Terms to know

Tint: mixture of a color with white, which increases lightness.

Shade: the mixture of a color with black, which reduces lightness.

Neutral color/achromatic color: reduces chroma or colorfulness, while the hue remains unchanged.

Complementary color: are pairs of colors that are of opposite hue in the color scale

Hue: the name of a color. Example: Red or Yellow

#### Procedure

Make your color swatches at least 3 inches square. Once dry, use a 1 inch hole punch/square punch (get it from me) to cut your final shapes. Organize your circles of hues into rows that each measure 8.5 inches and compose on a 12" x 12" piece of Stonehenge (see diagram at bottom of page). Space each row 1 inch from the next. Space each square or circle a 1/2 inch from the next. Centralize center row in middle of page and use glue stick to adhere.
